राष्ट्रभाषा हिंदी का महत्व

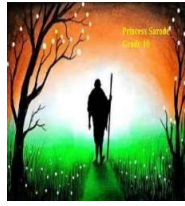
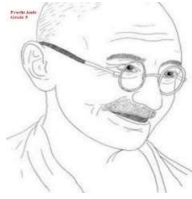

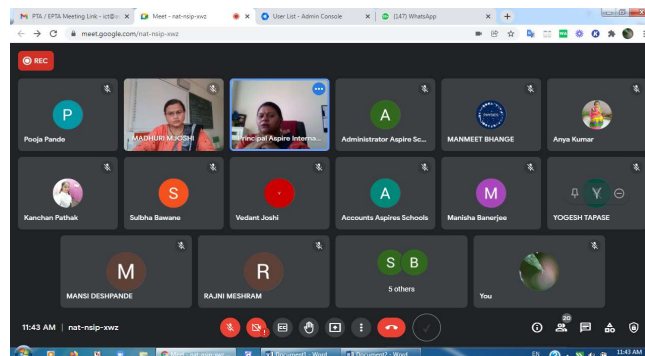
VACCINATION DOSE FOR STUDENTS
